



In 1969, the first vines were planted and a winery established in this area, which was traditionally sheep grazing pastures. As such, the locals considered it would only ever be one of a kind and thus the road leading to it was named “Winery Road”. Despite their doubts, the area has flourished and is now recognized as an official Wine Region.

VINTAGE 2021

Ideal Mediterranean winter rainfall and then cooler than average summer conditions resulted in a well-balanced vintage for the Currency Creek Wine Region in 2021.

Cooler than average mean temperatures through January and February delayed harvest compared to historical average start dates.

March and April temperatures continued to be below average with unusually low night-time temperatures. Picking from late March through to mid April meant the reds benefitted greatly from the mild, dry finish to the ripening season.

The prolonged ripening time ensured great varietal character, depth and colour.
