

In 1969, the first vines were planted and a winery established in this area, which was traditionally sheep grazing pastures. As such, the locals considered it would only ever be one of a kind and thus the road leading to it was named "Winery Road". Despite their doubts, the area has flourished and is now recognized as an official Wine Region.



VINTAGE 2023

Variable weather during Spring resulted in some yield variations within the district both between blocks and varieties. White varieties benefited from some early cooler climatic conditions and the maritime influence of the southern ocean, these conditions resulted in excellent quality, good fruit ripeness and naturally balanced acidity. Sparkling varieties were particularly impressive with harvest starting the last week of February, two weeks later than the previous vintage.
