As skilled craftsmen, they completed the most difficult work on the highest towers, oblivious to vertigo, gravity and mortality.

VINTAGE 2022

Average Winter rainfall followed by cooler than average Spring and Summer conditions resulted in a prolonged but well-balanced vintage for the Currency Creek wine region.

Variable weather during Spring resulted in some yield variations within the district both between blocks and varieties. Bunch numbers were excellent overall, however, berry set was variable.

White varieties benefited from some early cooler climatic conditions which resulted in excellent quality, good fruit ripeness and naturally balanced acidity.
