



In 1969, the first vines were planted and a winery established in this area, which was traditionally sheep grazing pastures. As such, the locals considered it would only ever be one of a kind and thus the road leading to it was named "Winery Road". Despite their doubts, the area has flourished and is now recognized as an official Wine Region.

VINTAGE 2018

After a variable start to bud burst and the season providing many disease challenges during the growing period and around veraison, a stretch of about four weeks of ideal ripening weather in the middle of vintage saved the season.

The weather conditions at flowering were variable but allowed good fruit set in most red varieties.

The reds were left hanging to gain full physiological maturity and were picked very late this year, with first fruit coming in from about 10th April.

Such prolonged hang time resulted in great varietal character and colour and red variety yields were generally as expected.
