



Currency Creek Estate is one of the jewels of the Fleurieu Peninsula, near the Adelaide Hills in South Australia. The Adelaide Hills where these grapes are grown produces exceptional parcels of these varieties as it enjoys a long cool ripening period—Perfect for producing wines of delicate fruit characters.

TASTING NOTE

The dominant Pinot Noir component produces a pretty pink tinge while adding an array of strawberry and cherry flavours. Fruit depth and texture is a contribution of the Chardonnay. Leading to a long lively and creamy finish.

VINTAGE 2019

Vintage 2019 in the Adelaide Hills was disappointing for grape growers as it returned the lowest grape yield for many seasons, being only around 50 per cent of the total harvested in the previous season. However, winemakers were pleased with the wine, apart from the low volume, as the region escaped the influence of the extreme January heat, seen across Australia, and had a long slow ripening in autumn.
