VINTAGE 2024.

Average winter rainfall followed by cool summer conditions resulted in a prolonged but well-balanced vintage for the Currency Creek Wine Region.

White varieties benefited from some early cooler climatic conditions & the maritime influence of the Southern Ocean.

Continued cooler than average mean temperatures through January & February eventually delayed harvest across most red varieties by 14-21 days when compared to the historical average start dates, many reds being picked after Easter.

The March & April temperatures continued to be below average, despite some heat spikes. Night-time temperatures were particularly low & were accompanied by frequent heavy dews.

Red varietals benefited greatly from the mild last few weeks of the summer.
