



Currency Creek Estate is one of the jewels of the Fleurieu Peninsula, near Adelaide in South Australia. Close to Lake Alexandrina and the Southern Ocean, the region enjoys a mild maritime climate, perfect for producing wines of delicate fruit driven complexity.

TASTING NOTE

An elegant sparkling made from a combination of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir with strawberry and cherry aromas on the nose. These fruit characters carry through to the palate which is creamy in texture and has a crisp, refreshing finish.

VINTAGE 2017

Cool, dry spring and early summer conditions through to the end of January allowed the whites to develop great flavours and high acidity. The Pinot Noir was picked later than past vintages and is showing exceptional fruit forward characters.

From January to end of February the temperature being no greater than 33 degrees and not falling at night below 19.5 degrees, very little wind and constant cloud cover. These combined conditions proved beautiful for fruit ripening. Fruit quality proved exceptional typically those on our lighter alluvial sands. Harvesting was completed in the first week of April.
