

In the days when ballast stone was an important feature of some of Australia's most iconic buildings, the daring Steeplejacks played a crucial role in their construction and maintenance. As skilled craftsmen, they completed the most difficult work on the highest towers, oblivious to vertigo, gravity and mortality.

VINTAGE 2023

Variable weather during Spring resulted in some yield variations within the district both between blocks and varieties. White varieties benefited from some early cooler climatic conditions and the maritime influence of the southern ocean, these conditions resulted in excellent quality, good fruit ripeness and naturally balanced acidity. Sparkling varieties were particularly impressive with harvest starting the last week of February, two weeks later than the previous vintage.
